EVENTS & FESTIVALS

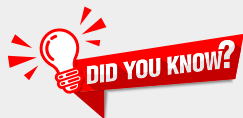

- Port:** Singapore, the largest port in Southeast Asia and among the world's busiest, owes its growth and prosperity to its strategic location at the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula. Here, it commands the Strait of Malacca, a crucial passage connecting the Indian Ocean to the South China Sea, symbolizing its significance as a global maritime hub.
- Aviation:** Singapore serves as a global connector, with flights to destinations across the Asia Pacific region, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa. Changi Airport, Singapore's premier aviation hub, stands as a gateway to the world, offering seamless travel experiences and opening doors to limitless adventures.

- Land:** Over the last two centuries, Singapore's land area has grown by an impressive 25 percent, from 578 to 719 sq km. This expansion is due to land reclamation, not natural forces.
- Population:** Singapore's population of about 6 million is primarily composed of ethnic Chinese, making up 74.3%, followed by Malays at 13.5%, Indians at 9.0%, and other ethnicities at 3.2% as of 2020.

However, there were no records of lions native to Singapore. It might have been a tiger that he saw, for tigers used to be found in the wild in Singapore up until the 1930s.

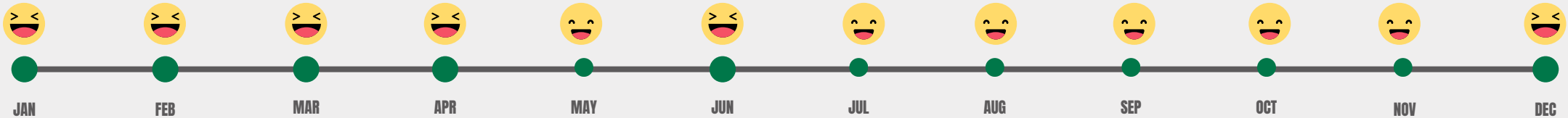
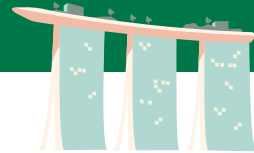

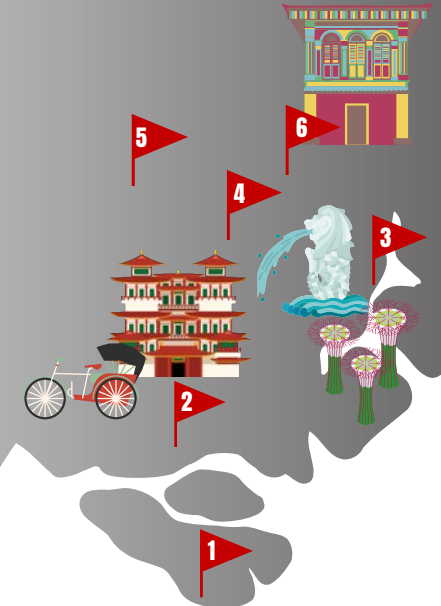
