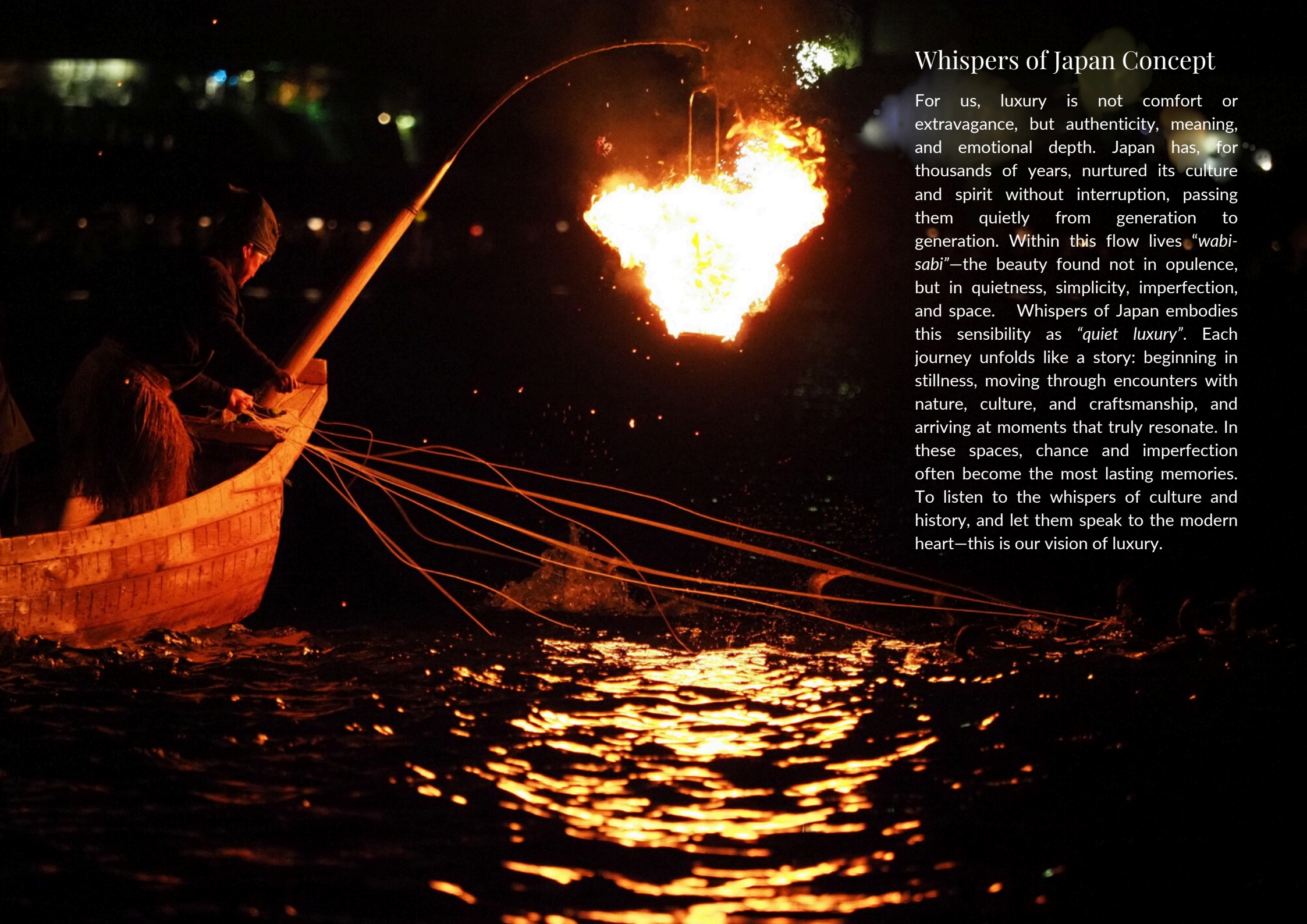

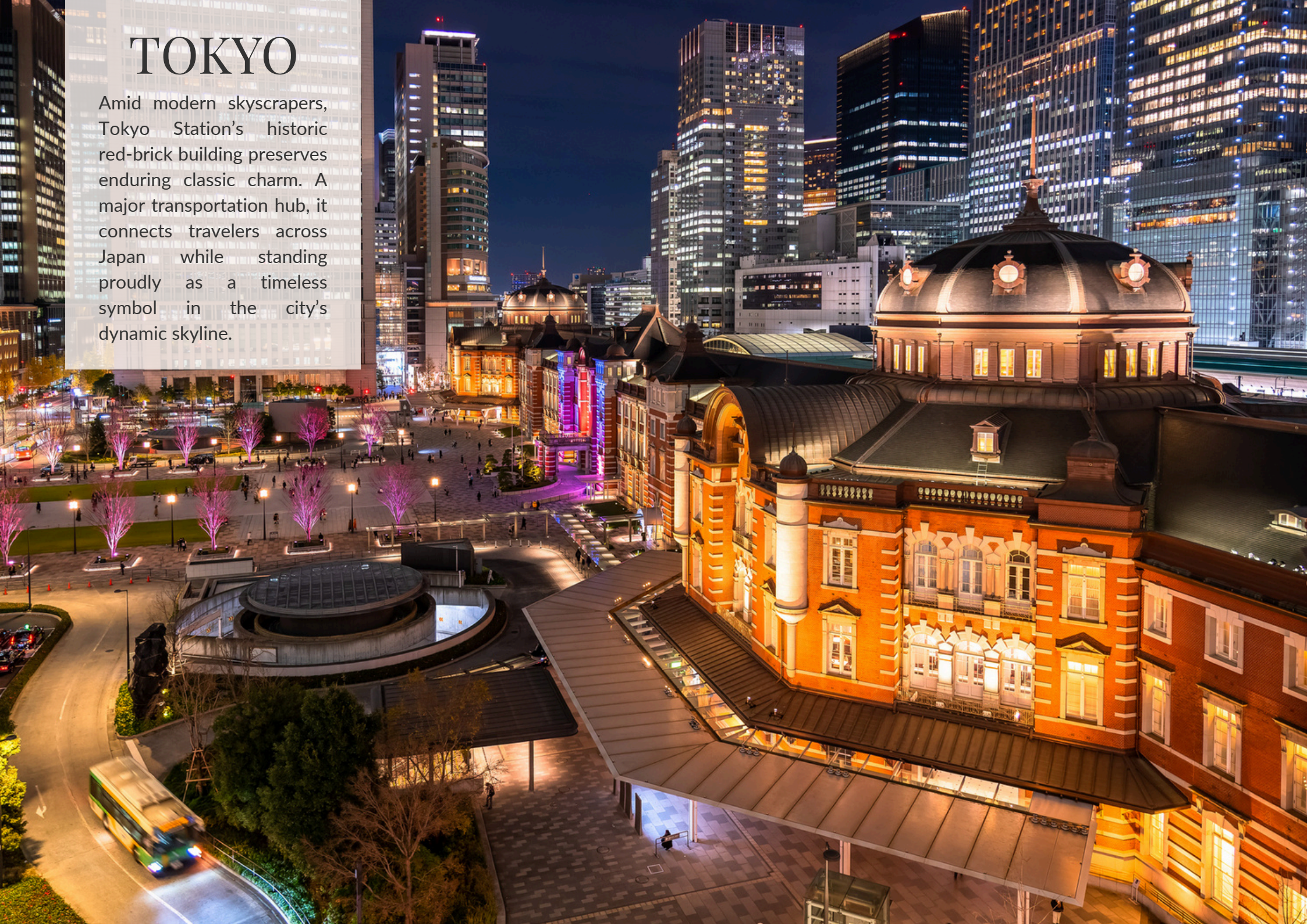

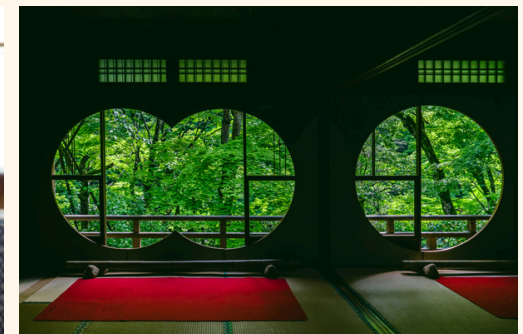

### 2. Preliminary Itinerary and Quote



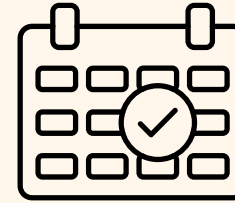
Based on this, we will present a preliminary itinerary (a high-level draft) along with an estimated quote. There is no charge for this stage.

### 3. Proposal Acceptance and Deposit



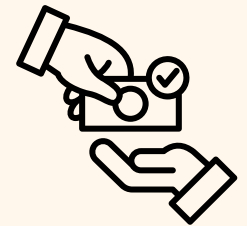
If you're satisfied with the proposal, we will request a deposit of JPY 150,000 per person (approx. USD 1,000) to secure accommodations and begin the official booking process.

### 4. Detailed Itinerary Adjustments



Once the deposit is received, we proceed with itinerary planning and logistics. We will share the itinerary, followed by three revisions to refine your journey.

### 5. Final Payment and Confirmation



After the itinerary is finalized, we will issue an invoice for the remaining balance. The balance, minus the deposit, must be paid within 30 days of final confirmation.
